




FIG. 1—T675F MOUNTING DIMENSIONS IN in. [mm IN BRACKETS].

INSTALLATION

WHEN INSTALLING THIS PRODUCT ...

- Read these instructions carefully. Failure to follow them could damage the product or cause a hazardous condition.
- 2. Check the ratings given in the instructions and on the product to make sure the product is suitable for your application.
- 3. Installer must be a trained, experienced service technician.
- 4. After installation is complete, check out product operation as provided in these instructions.

CAUTION

- Disconnect power supply before beginning installation to prevent electrical shock and equipment damage.
- Avoid kinking or excessive bending of the tubing as it causes the tubing to become hard and brittle.

LOCATION AND MOUNTING

Both controller case and sensing bulb can be mounted in any position. Place the bulb in the discharge air duct in an area with good air circulation at average temperatures. The bulb must sense the true temperature of the discharge air; include at least five feet of the capillary tubing with the bulb in the duct. Provide adequate supports for the bulb and tubing. Do not uncoil more tubing than is required; avoid kinking or excessive bending of the tubing.

The T675F controller case mounts with three screws through holes in back of the case. Fig. 2 shows a typical installation of the T675F in a crop dryer.

- IMPORTANT -

When replacing cover, capillary tube should be routed as shown in Fig. 4.

WIRING

Disconnect power supply before beginning installation to prevent electrical shock and equipment damage.




FIG. 3—TYPICAL T675F CONTROLLER WIRING.

All wiring must agree with local codes and ordinances. Refer to installation information furnished with the equipment and to Fig. 3 below.




FIG. 2—TYPICAL CROP DRYER AND CROP-TROL INSTALLATION.

SETTING




FIG. 4—ADJUSTABLE DIFFERENTIAL SCALE AND LEVER.

Use the knob located beneath the control setting scale to turn scale to the desired set point. The scale setting is the cut-out point; switch opens R to B and closes R to W. The cut-in point is the scale setting minus differential; switch opens R to W and closes R to B. To set differential, remove cover from the T675F. Move the differential adjustment wheel to the desired set point on the differential scale (Fig. 4). Replace control cover; it should be on the control at all times. No lubrication is required.

CHECKOUT

With temperature and differential set as desired, operate the system until equipment cuts out. Note the set point. Slowly turn the setting lever upscale until equipment cuts in, and note the new setting. The difference between settings should approximately

equal the differential setting. Lower temperature scale to original set point; equipment should cut out within a few minutes. If equipment does not cut in and cut out properly, adjust differential until equipment operates as intended.
